Wildly reshaped forms of church and extreme missional thinking proliferate as the modern church comes to terms with the radically changed culture. Much of this is necessary. However, in the midst of the ecclesiological stretching, there are certain crucial questions that are emerging. 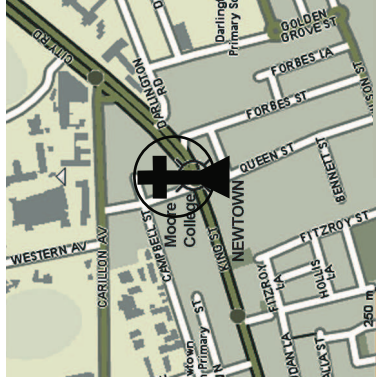
